PREFFERED APPLICATION TOOLS:

- 1. Low Pressure Sprayer with fan tip. Do not exceed 50 PSI.
- 2. Natural Bristle Brush.
- 3. Lambs Wool Roller. 1/2" Nap.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES:

- 1. Apply one coat of product to a small, inconspicuous, clean and dry test area. If Lifeguard Low Sheen does not produce results in any way which are not satisfactory, discontinue its use and contact a Lifeguard Customer Service representative. The finish should not be tacky. Wait at lease 24 hours to determine compatibility.
- 2. Allow at least 48 hours of drying time after power-washing.
- 3. Be sure to mask off glass, plastic and metal. Protect plants, grass and other materials by shielding or covering.
- 4. Avoid application on DIRTY OR WET surfaces Do not apply to previously painted, sealed or stained surfaces. Protect freshly coated surfaces from dust, rain and traffic while drying.

LIMITATION:

- 1. Do not apply in direct sunlight, when the surface temperature is below 50°F or above 80°F, or in windy conditions.
- 2. Allow new mortar to cure for at least three weeks.
- 3. Do not use on porcelain or ceramic tile.

DRYING TIME:

- 1. Allow at least 12 hours for foot traffic.
- 2. 24 hours for water exposure.
- 3. 72 hours for vehicle traffic.

CLEAN UP:

- 1. Lifeguard Low Sheen cleans up easily with Lacquer Thinner.
- 2. Equipment must be thoroughly cleaned after use.

CAUTIONS:

- 1. Lifeguard Low sheen is slippery when applied. Keep all traffic off the treated surface until dry.
- 2. Concrete pavers may contain an integral mold release agent. A white haze can appear after application.

- 3. Absorbent substrate may wick moisture or water from the ground, causing efflorescence and discoloration.
- 4. Treated surfaces are slippery when wet.

COVERAGE RATES: *ESTIMATED COVERAGE

Estimated coverage is between 50-175 Sq.Ft./Gal.
